## **REQUEST TO RE-OPEN AND AMEND ORDER 535-246**

- 1. In its Verified Application filed November 2, 2012, ConocoPhillips Company ("ConocoPhillips") petitioned the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (the "Commission") for an order to establish four approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing units for production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation, and well location rules applicable to such wells, in the above-captioned lands in Arapahoe County, Colorado.
- 2. The Application and Rule 511 submission requested that the spacing units and well location rules established in the requested order be applicable to the drilling and production of horizontal wells only, with vertical and directional wells to the Niobrara Formation remaining subject to Commission Rule 318.a. or such other orders as may be entered by the Commission.
- 3. However, the resulting Order 535-246 was silent as to whether vertical and directional wells to the Niobrara Formation would remain subject to Commission Rule 318.a. or such other orders as may be entered by the Commission. Order 535-246 provided that the "Commission expressly reserves its right, after notice and hearing, to alter, amend or repeal any and/or all of the above orders."

WHEREFORE, the Applicant, ConocoPhillips respectfully requests that Order 535-246 be amended to expressly provide that vertical and directional wells to the Niobrara Formation in the above-captioned Application Lands will not be subject to said Order, but shall remain subject to Commission Rule 318.a. or such other orders as may be entered by the Commission.
