APPLICATION

COMES NOW Condor Energy Technology LLC ("Applicant"), by its attorneys, Beatty & Wozniak, P.C., and makes application to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado ("Commission") for an order pooling all interests in a 640-acre unit for the development of the Niobrara Formation on the following described lands:

Township 7 North, Range 60 West, 6th P.M. Section 32: All

Weld County, Colorado (hereinafter "Application Lands").

In support of its application, Applicant states and alleges as follows:

- 1. Applicant is a limited liability company duly authorized to conduct business in the State of Colorado, and is a registered operator in good standing with the Commission.
- 2. Applicant holds the right to operate for a substantial portion of the Application Lands.
- 3. On May 29, 2012, the Commission issued Order No. 407-642 which, among other things, established various 640-acre and 1280-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation, authorizing up to four horizontal wells to be located within each unit with the treated interval of any horizontal well to be no closer than 460 feet from the boundaries of the unit, without exception being granted by the Director. Section 32 Township 7 North, Range 60 West 6th P.M. is subject to this Order with regard to a 640-acre drilling and spacing unit.
- 4. Applicant, pursuant to Commission Rule 530 and the provisions of C.R.S. § 34-60-116 (6) and (7), seeks an order to pool all interests, including but not limited to, any nonconsenting interests, in the Application Lands consisting of the 640-acre unit for the development of the Niobrara Formation, said order to apply to the Kuhn 32-1H well ("Well") and any of the four subsequent wells drilled in the unit.
- 5. Applicant requests that the Commission's pooling order be made effective as of the earlier of the date of this Application, or the date that the costs specified in C.R.S. § 34-60-

116(7)(b)(II) are first incurred for the drilling of the Well, or any of the three subsequent wells drilled in the unit to the Niobrara Formation on the Application Lands.

- 6. Applicant certifies that copies of this Application will be served on all persons owning an interest in the mineral estate of the tracts to be pooled within seven (7) days of the date hereof, as required by Rule 507.b(2), and that at least thirty (30) days prior to the hearing on this matter, each such interest owner not already leased or voluntarily pooled will be offered the opportunity to lease, or to participate in the drilling of the Well, and will be provided with the information required by Rule 530.
- 7. That in order to prevent waste and to protect correlative rights, all interests in the Application Lands and the 640-acre unit should be pooled for the orderly development of the Niobrara Formation, including any nonconsenting interests therein.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this matter be set for hearing at the next available opportunity, that notice be given as required by law, and that upon such hearing, the Commission enter its order:

- A. Pooling all interests in the 640-acre unit on the Application Lands for the development of the Niobrara Formation.
- B. Providing that the Commission's pooling order is made effective as of the earlier of the date of this Application, or the date that the costs specified in C.R.S. § 34-60-116(7)(b)(II) are first incurred for the drilling of the Well or any of the three subsequent wells drilled in the unit to the Niobrara Formation on the Application Lands.
- C. Providing that the interests of any owners with whom the Applicant has been unable to secure a lease or other agreement to participate in the drilling of the authorized wells are pooled by operation of statute, pursuant to C.R.S. § 34-60-116(7), and made subject to the cost recovery provisions thereof.
- D. For such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable in this matter.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that this matter be set for hearing in May 2013, that notice be given as required by law, and that upon such hearing, the Commission enter its order consistent with Applicant's request as set forth above.
