APPLICATION

Dakota Exploration, LLC ("Applicant"), by and through its attorneys, Beatty & Wozniak, P.C., respectfully submits this Application to the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (the "Commission"), pursuant to C.R.S. 34-60-116, for an order to establish an approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation in the following lands:

Township 11 North, Range 59 West, 6th P.M. Section 11: All

Weld County, Colorado ("Application Lands").

In support thereof, Applicant states and alleges as follows:

- 1. Applicant is a limited liability company duly authorized to conduct business in the State of Colorado, and is a registered operator in good standing with the Commission.
- 2. Applicant holds the right to operate in the Application Lands. A reference map of the Application Lands is attached hereto.
- 3. Rule 318.a. of the Rules and Regulations of the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission requires that, on unspaced lands, wells drilled in in excess of two thousand five hundred (2,500) feet in depth shall be located not less than six hundred (600) feet from any lease line, and shall be located not less than one thousand two hundred (1,200) feet from any other producible or drilling oil or gas well when drilling to the same source of supply, unless authorized by order of the Commission upon hearing. There are no other specific Commission Orders applicable to the Niobrara Formation underlying the Application Lands.
- 4. Applicant requests that the Commission establish an approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit on the Application Lands for the development and operation of the Niobrara Formation.
- 5. Applicant requests that it be authorized to drill and complete four (4) horizontal wells within the unit on the Application Lands with no more than one wellpad located within each quarter quarter section, and the treated interval of the horizontal well located no closer than 600' from the boundaries of the drilling and spacing unit, without exception being granted by the Director.

- 6. Applicant asserts that establishing an approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing units on the Application Lands will allow for economic and efficient drainage of the Niobrara Formation; will prevent waste; will not adversely affect correlative rights and will assure the greatest ultimate recovery of oil and associated hydrocarbon substances from the Niobrara Formation. The 640-acre drilling and spacing units are not smaller than the maximum area that can be economically and efficiently drained by the proposed well in the Niobrara Formation within each unit.
- 7. That the names and addresses of the interested parties according to the information and belief of the Applicant are set forth in <u>Exhibit A</u> attached hereto and made a part hereof, and the undersigned certifies that copies of this Application shall be served on each interested party within the next seven days as required by Rule 503.e.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that this matter be set for hearing, that notice be given as required by law and that upon such hearing this Commission enter its order:

- A. Establishing the Application Lands as an approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Niobrara Formation and authorizing four (4) horizontal wells within the unit, with no more than one wellpad located within each quarter quarter section.
- B. Providing that the treated interval of the horizontal well shall be no closer than 600' from the boundaries of the drilling and spacing unit.
- C. Finding that the approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing units will prevent waste, protect correlative rights, and will maximize the efficient and economic production of the Niobrara Formation on the Application Lands; and
 - D. Granting any other relief as may be appropriate.
