#### **VERIFIED APPLICATION**

Quicksilver Resources Inc. (the "Applicant"), through its attorneys, Bjork Lindley Little PC, respectfully submits this application to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado (the "Commission" or "COGCC") for an order establishing an approximately 949-acre exploratory drilling and spacing unit for the drilling of up to four horizontal wells and up to four additional vertical or directional wells to be completed in and produce from the Niobrara Formation underlying certain lands in Routt County, Colorado. In support of this application, the Applicant states as follows:

1. The Applicant owns leasehold interests authorizing it to drill and operate wells in the Niobrara Formation in the following lands located in Routt County, Colorado:

Township 7 North, Range 87 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., Routt County, Colorado Section 25: Lots 1 through 16, a/k/a All Section 26: E½

(the "Application Lands").

- 2. A reference map identifying and depicting the Application Lands is attached as Exhibit A. No wells have been drilled in the Application Lands.
- 3. The Application Lands are unspaced with respect to the Niobrara or any other formation and are presently subject to COGCC Rule 318.a. This Rule provides that wells greater than 2,500 feet in depth may be drilled no closer than 600 feet to a lease boundary and no closer than 1200 feet to another well producing from the same formation.
- 4. No other orders have been issued by the COGCC for the Application Lands. The Application Lands are not located in or near a named oil and gas field. Nor are they located in or near any city, town or high density area.

#### Jurisdiction and Parties

- 5. The Commission has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to § 34-60-116, C.R.S. and other law.
- 6. The Applicant, a Delaware corporation, is an oil and gas operator in good standing with the Commission and is otherwise authorized to do business in Colorado.
- 7. The Applicant presently owns leasehold interests in a majority of the Application Lands. The Applicant has standing pursuant to Rule 503.b. to apply for the requested relief.
- 8. The minerals beneath the Application Lands are subject to several oil and gas leases and it will be necessary to drill across lease lines to develop horizontal wells on the Application Lands.
- 9. Exhibit B is a list of all owners within the Application Lands and other interested parties as defined in COGCC Rules. Exhibit B reflects the best information now known to the Applicant about each of these persons and entities and, to the extent presently known, includes the last known address reflected in county or other records for each of them.

#### **Drilling and Spacing Unit Request**

- 10. The Applicant requests the Commission establish a single approximately 949-acre, more or less, exploratory drilling and spacing unit consisting of the Application Lands within which, at the option of the Applicant or other operator, up to four horizontal wells and up to four additional vertical or directional wells may be drilled. The Applicant also requests the Commission order that, unless an exception or variance is granted by the Director, the treated intervals of the permitted wellbores be no closer than 600 feet from the exterior boundaries of the proposed drilling and spacing unit, without any required setback from interior lease lines, and the minimum permitted distance between wellbores should be no less than 150 feet.
- 11. The Niobrara Formation beneath the Application Lands is thought to contain common accumulations of oil, gas or associated hydrocarbons which may be economically produced. The Niobrara Formation can be mapped regionally throughout the Sandwash Basin and is expected to be approximately 1,200 feet thick beneath the Application Lands. The Applicant believes the Niobrara Formation has both conventional and unconventional production characteristics.
- 12. There are numerous examples of vertical wells associated with geologic structures in the Sandwash Basin producing from the Niobrara Formation with initial rates in excess of 200 BOPD and/or cumulative production greater than 100 MBbls. These vertical wells often have had minimal or no fracture stimulations by the operator, yet recover large volumes of hydrocarbon from this relatively low permeability and low porosity formation because, it is believed, these well bores have penetrated open fractured rock. It is believed that economic horizontal wells, as well as additional vertical or directional wells, may be developed in the Application Lands and effectively drain them by intercepting open fracture networks in this formation and also using fracture stimulations to both enhance communication with nearby fracture networks and obtain contributions from the intercepted unconventional tight rock.

- 13. The Applicant or other operator should be given flexibility using available data to select the best possible well locations within the proposed drilling and spacing unit, including those locations which might be within 600 feet of an interior lease line within the proposed drilling and spacing unit, for the drilling of the requested wells.
- 14. Entry of the relief proposed in this Application will promote the efficient and effective drainage of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Application Lands, prevent waste and protect correlative rights in a manner consistent with public health, safety and welfare, the protection of the environment and wildlife resources and the other requirements of law.
- 15. The Applicant certifies that copies of this application shall be served on each interested party listed in Exhibit B within seven days of the filing of this application as provided in Commission Rule 503. An affidavit and certificate of service attesting to the mailing of the application to those persons entitled to notice also shall be filed with the Commission as required by COGCC Rules.

#### **Conclusion**

16. Applicant respectfully requests that this matter be set for hearing in December 2013, that notice be given as required by law, and that upon such hearing the Commission enter its order consistent with Applicant's requests and proposals as set forth above.




