APPLICATION

COMES NOW Noble Energy, Inc. ("Applicant"), by and through its attorneys, Jost & Shelton Energy Group, P.C., and respectfully submits this Application to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado ("Commission"), for an order declaring a Pending Order of the Commission, as defined below, applicable to previously unlocatable parties. The pending pooling order, found in Docket No. 1407-UP-226 ("Pending Order"), seeks to pool all interests in two approximate 720-acre designated horizontal wellbore spacing units ("WSU") for the drilling of the Shable K08-69HN well (API No. 05-123-39558), in WSU #1, and the Shable K08-69-1HN well (API No. 05-123-39561), in WSU #2 ("Wells"), for the development of the Niobrara Formation underlying:

Township 4 North, Range 66 West, 6th P.M.

Section 3: SW1/4SW1/4 Section 4: S1/2S1/2

Section 5: S½S½

Section 8: N½N½

Section 9: N½N½

Section 10: NW1/4NW1/4

720-acres, more or less, Weld County, Colorado (hereinafter "Application Lands")

In support of its application, Applicant states and avers as follows:

- 1. Applicant is a corporation duly authorized to conduct business in the State of Colorado and is an operator in good standing with the Commission.
 - 2. Applicant owns certain leasehold interests in the Application Lands.
- 3. On February 19, 1992, the Commission entered Order No. 407-87 (amended August 20, 1993), which among other things, established 80-acre drilling and

spacing units for the production of oil and/or gas from the Niobrara Formation underlying certain lands, with the permitted well locations in accordance with the provisions of Order No. 407-1 and allowed downhole commingling of production from the Codell and Niobrara Formations.

- 4. On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, which, among other things, allowed certain drilling locations to be utilized to drill or twin a well, deepen a well or recomplete a well and to commingle any or all of the Cretaceous Age Formations from the base of the Dakota Formation to the surface. On December 5, 2005, Rule 318A was amended to allow interior infill and boundary wells to be drilled and wellbore spacing units to be established. On August 8, 2011, Rule 318A was again amended to, among other things, address the drilling of horizontal wells.
- 5. Docket No. 1407-UP-226 is set to be heard before the Commission on July 28, 2014 and seeks authorization to pool all interests in two approximate 720-acre designated horizontal wellbore spacing units for the Application Lands, for the development and operation of the Niobrara Formation.
- 6. Applicant has since located additional interested parties who are the successors in interest to parties who had not been previously located because they appeared to be defunct entities or deceased individuals with no heirs and/or devisees. The interested parties have not previously received notice of the pooling application found in Docket No. 1407-UP-226.
- 7. Applicant is not seeking cost recovery provisions pursuant to C.R.S. § 34-60-116(6) and (7) only to such additional interested parties.
- 8. The grounds upon which Applicant seek the Pending Order still pertain. Specifically:
- a. Applicant owns substantial leasehold interests in the Application Lands.
- b. The Application Lands are subject to Docket 1407-UP-226 which seeks to establish two approximate 720-acre designated horizontal wellbore spacing units for the Niobrara Formation.
- c. Applicant intends to drill the Shable K08-69HN well, and the Shable K08-69-1HN well for the production of oil and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation underlying the Application Lands.
- 9. Applicant requests that the Commission subject the unnoticed interested parties to the Pending Order, as such Pending Order is made as of the earlier of the date of the original pooling application, dated May 29, 2014, except that such unnoticed parties not be subjected to the cost recovery provisions pursuant to C.R.S. § 34-60-116(6) and (7).

10. Applicant certifies that copies of this Application will be served on all persons owning an interest in the mineral estate of the tracts to be pooled within seven (7) days of the date hereof, as required by Rule 507.b(2), and that at least thirty (30) days prior to the hearing on this matter. The list of such interested parties is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this matter be set for hearing, that notice thereof be given as required by law, and that upon such hearing the Commission enter its order declaring the Pending Order applicable to the said previously unnoticed interest owners, and for such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable in the premises.
