VERIFIED APPLICATION

COMES NOW, Ward Petroleum Corporation, ("Ward" or "Applicant") by its attorneys, Lohf Shaiman Jacobs Hyman & Feiger PC, and submits its Application to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado, for an order to subject all nonconsenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of C.R.S. §34-60-116(7) for the drilling of Additional Wells in an approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit for production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations in certain lands in the Wattenberg Field, Adams County, Colorado, and in support states as follows:

- 1. Applicant is duly authorized to conduct business in the State of Colorado and is a registered operator with the Commission, Operator No.10359.
- 2. Applicant owns leasehold interests in the following described lands in Adams County, Colorado, containing approximately 640-acres (hereinafter, the "Application Lands"):

Township 1 South, Range 67 West, 6th P.M. Section 14

- 3. On June 17, 2014, the Commission issued Order 407-1038, which, among other things, established the Application Lands as an approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit for production of oil, gas and assorted hydrocarbons from horizontal wells to the Codell and Niobrara Formations.
- 4. On June 17, 2014, the Commissioner entered Order No. 407-1076 which, among other things, pooled all interests in the unit; and subjected all nonconsenting interests to the cost recovery penalties provided by C.R.S. §34-60-116(7) for the Todd Creek Farms #14-4-4HN and the Todd Creek Farms #14-4-3HC wells (the "Initial Wells").
- 5. Applicant now proposes to drill the SHL Ward Riverdale #14-4-12HC and the SHL Ward Riverdale #14-4-11HN wells (the "Additional Wells") in the unit for production of oil, gas and assorted hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations, respectively.

- 6. The names and addresses of those persons who own any interest in the mineral estate in the Application Lands, exclusive of overriding royalty interests, according to the information and belief of the Applicant as of the date of this Application, are set forth on **Exhibit A**. Copies of this Application shall be served on all such owners within seven (7) days of the date of this Application, as required by Commission Rule 503.e.
- 7. At least thirty (30) days prior to the hearing on this Application, the Applicant will have sent all owners who have not previously consented to lease or otherwise participate in the drilling and completion of the Additional Wells, an Authority for Expenditures (AFE) and/or supporting documents which contain all information required by Commission Rule 530.b., and in case of unleased mineral owners, an offer to lease which is reasonable based on the factors listed in Commission Rule 530.c.
- 8. Applicant anticipates that one or more of such owners will refuse or fail to respond to such offer to lease and/or to participate in the drilling, completion and operation of such Additional Wells, and shall be deemed non-consenting parties under Commission Rule 530.b and c.
- 9. An order of the Commission subjecting all nonconsenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of C.R.S. §34-60-116(7) for the drilling of the Additional Wells to the Codell and Niobrara Formations shall therefore be necessary in order to afford each owner of an interest in the unit the opportunity to recover and receive its just and equitable share of the oil and/or gas underlying the unit.
- 10. The granting of the requested order would not be prejudicial to the owners in the unit and would protect correlative rights.
- 11. The requested order should be effective as of the date of this Application, or the date that costs specified by C.R.S. §34-60-116(7)(b) are first incurred by Applicant for the drilling of either of the Additional Wells, whichever is first in time.

WHEREFORE, the Applicant respectfully requests this matter be set for hearing, notice be given as required by law, and upon such hearing this Commission enter its order to subject all nonconsenting interests in the unit to the cost recovery provisions of C.R.S. §34-60-116(7) for the drilling of the Additional Wells, under such terms as are fair, reasonable and required by law.
