On October 31, 2011, the Commission entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Gunnison County for purposes of : 1) continuing their joint discussion to clarify and coordinate the application of their respective regulatory programs; 2) scheduling and conducting regular coordination meetings; 3) taking specific actions to make most beneficial use of the Commission's Local Government Designee ("LGD") process; 4) taking specific actions regarding assignment by the Commission to Gunnison County of certain Commission inspection authority and monitoring functions; and 5) committing to enter into formal intergovernmental agreements to implement actions that result from the MOU.

The Commission and Gunnison County have completed negotiations on a proposed intergovernmental agreement (IGA) as contemplated by the MOU.
