NOTICE OF HEARING

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Pursuant to Rule 522.c., the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission ("Commission" or "COGCC") Staff will apply to the Commission at its January 27-28, 2014 hearing for an Order Finding Violation ("OFV") against Stehle Oil Company.

Stehle Oil Company ("Stehle") is Operator No. 82440, and has produced oil and gas from five wells from January 1999 to the present.

Rule 309 of the Rules and Regulations and Rules of Practice and Procedure of the Commission (2 CCR 404-1) requires each oil and gas well operator or producer to file Form 7, Operator's Monthly Production Report, within forty-five days after the month in which production occurs.

On July 12, 2013, Commission Staff issued a Notice of Alleged Violation ("NOAV") (No. 200382924) to Stehle for violation of Rule 309 of COGCC Rules of Practice and Procedure, 2 CCR 404-1 ("Rule" or "Rules")s for failure to file Form 7s for the following wells:

NOAV No. 200382924 required Stehle to submit each missing report to the COGCC by August 12, 2013. Stehle did not comply with this deadline.

COGCC staff requests that Stehle be found in violation of rules as cited above and assessed a penalty pursuant to Rule 523.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, pursuant to: 1) the general jurisdiction granted to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado ("Commission") under § 34-60-105, C.R.S.; 2) specific powers granted pursuant to §34-60-106 C.R.S.; 3) the Colorado Administrative Procedures Act at § 24-4-105 C.R.S.; and 4) the Commission's

In accordance with Rule 509, any interested party desiring to protest the granting of the application or to intervene on the application must file with the Commission a written protest or intervention no later than January 10, 2014, briefly stating the basis of the protest or intervention. Any interested party must file an original and two (2) copies with the Commission, along with an electronic version. Pursuant to Rule 503.g., if a party who has received notice under Rule 503.b. wishes to receive further pleadings in the above-referenced matter, that party must file a protest or intervention in accordance with these rules.
