NOTICE OF HEARING

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Pursuant to Rule 522.c., the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission ("Commission" or "COGCC") Staff will apply to the Commission at its March 17-18 hearing for an Order Finding Violation ("OFV") against Hyndrex Resources ("Hyndrex") (Operator No. 42640).

Hyndrex is the operator of the following Wells in Adams County:

These Wells have not produced since November 2010. On August 1, 2013, Commission staff sent Hyndrex a letter notifying them that these Wells were out of compliance with the Mechanical Integrity Testing (MIT) requirements for Shut-in Wells. This letter gave Hyndrex until November 1, 2013 to bring the Wells into compliance. To date, however, these Wells are still out of compliance.

On January 8, 2014, Commission staff issued Hyndrex Notices of Alleged Violation ("NOAVs") (No. 200393530; 200393531) for violations at the Wells described above. Both NOAVs cited one violation of the following COGCC Rule of Practice and Procedure, 2 CCR 404-1 ("Rule" or "Rules").

**Rule 326.b.1 (Mechanical Integrity Testing, Shut-in Wells)**

COGCC staff requests that Hyndrex be found in violation of rules cited above and assessed a penalty pursuant to Rule 523.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, pursuant to: 1) the general jurisdiction granted to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado (Commission) under § 34-60-105 C.R.S.; 2) specific powers granted pursuant to § 34-60-106 C.R.S.; 3) the Colorado Administrative Procedures Act at § 24-4-105 C.R.S.; and 4) the Commission's Series 500 Rules at 2CCR 404-1, that the Commission has scheduled the above-entitled matter for hearing on:

In accordance with Rule 509., any interested party desiring to protest the granting of the application or to intervene on the application should file with the Commission a written protest or intervention no later than March 3, 2014, briefly stating the basis of the protest or intervention. One electronic, one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of March 3, 2014. Pursuant to Rule 503.g., if a party who has received notice under Rule 503.b. wishes to receive further pleadings in the above-referenced matter, that party must file a protest or intervention in accordance with these rules.
