SECOND AMENDED APPLICATION

On April 17, 2014 (Amended May 29, 2014), Kerr-McGee Oil & Gas Onshore LP ("Kerr-McGee" or "Applicant") filed a verified Second Amended Application pursuant to §34-60-116 C.R.S. for an order to:

- 1) Pool all interests within each of eight approximate 200 to 640-acre wellbore spacing units established for the Application Lands for the Codell and Niobrara Formations; and
- 2) Subject any nonconsenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of C.R.S. §34-60-116(7), for the drilling of the Vogl State 16C-36HZ Well (API No. Pending) for development and operation of the Codell Formation (WSU #1), the Vogl State 39N-36HZ Well (API No. 05-123-38834) for development and operation of the Niobrara Formation (WSU #2), the Vogl State 38N-36HZ Well (API No. Pending) for development and operation of the Niobrara Formation (WSU #3), the Barefoot State 9C-36HZ Well (API No. 05-123-38631) for development and operation of the Codell Formation (WSU #4), the Barefoot State 40N-36HZ Well (API No. 05-123-38632) for development and operation of the Niobrara Formation (WSU #5), the Vogl 33N-35HZ Well (API No. 05-123-38835) for development and operation of the Niobrara Formation (WSU #6), the Vogl 13C-35HZ Well (API No. 05-123-38833) for development and operation of the Codell Formation (WSU #7), and the Vogl 34N-35-HZ Well (API No. Pending) for development and operation of the Niobrara Formation (WSU #8).

One electronic (cogcc.hearings_unit@state.co.us), one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. **Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of July 14, 2014.** Pursuant to Rule 511., if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing, based on review of the merits of the verified application and supporting exhibits.
