NOTICE OF HEARING

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Rule 325.a. of the Rule and Regulations of the Oil and gas Conservation Commission states no person shall commence operations for the underground disposal of water, or any other fluids, into a Class II well, or any well regulated by the Commission, nor shall any person commence construction of such a well,, without having first obtained written authorization for such operations from the Director.

On May 21, 2014, High Plains Disposal, Inc. ("High Plains") submitted Form 31 – Underground Injection Formation Permit Application and Form 33 – Injection Well Permit Application ("Applications"), seeking permission to drill and operate a proposed Class II underground injection control well, the HPD Platteville 2 Well on the below-described lands, for disposal of Class II wastewater into the Denver-Julesburg Injection Zone, including Lyons Formation and Fountain Formation and all formations in between:

Township 3 North, Range 66 West, 6th P.M.
Section 24: Northeast ¼ Northeast ¼

Notice of the High Plains Applications was given as specified by Rule 325.n.

One electronic (cogcc.hearings_unit@state.co.us), one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. **Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of July 14, 2014.** Pursuant to Rule 511., if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing, based on review of the merits of the verified application and supporting exhibits.
