NOTICE OF HEARING

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Pursuant to Rule 522.c., the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission ("Commission" or "COGCC") Staff will apply to the Commission at its July 28 & 29, 2014, hearing for an Order Finding Violation ("OFV") against Dejour Energy (USA) Corporation ("Dejour") (Operator No. 10301), pursuant to the allegations made in the below-described Notices of Alleged Violation ("NOAVs").

Dejour is the operator of record of the Federal 6/7-14-21 Well (API # 05-045-21180), the Federal 6/7-15-21 Well (API # 05-045-21181), the Federal 6/7-13-21 Well (API # 05-045-21182) and the Federal 6/7-16-21 Well (API # 05-045-21182) ("Wells") located in Garfield County, Colorado.

On May 1 and May 27, 2014, COGCC Staff issued NOAV Nos. 200403283, 200403552, 200403300, 200403594, 200403301, 200403616, 200403302 and 200403619 citing violations of Section 34-60-121(1) C.R.S. (Permit Conditions) and COGCC Rules of Practice and Procedure, 2 CCR 404-1 ("Rule"), Rule 316C (Notice of Hydraulic Fracturing Treatment), Rule 308B (Form 5A Filing Requirements), and Rule 205A (Frac Focus Reporting).

COGCC staff requests that Dejour be found in violation of Section 34-60-121(1) C.R.S., Rule 205A, Rule 308B, and Rule 316C and assessed a penalty pursuant to Rule 523, and other relief as authorized by law.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, pursuant to: 1) the general jurisdiction granted to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado (Commission) under § 34-60-105 C.R.S.; 2) specific powers granted pursuant to § 34-60-106 C.R.S.; 3) the Colorado Administrative Procedures Act at § 24-4-105 C.R.S.; and 4) the Commission's 500 Series Rules at 2 CCR 404-1, that the Commission has scheduled the above-entitled matter for hearing on:

Pursuant to said hearing in the above-entitled matter at the time and place aforesaid, or at any adjourned meeting, the Commission will enter such orders as it deems appropriate to protect the health, safety and welfare of the public and to prevent the waste of oil and gas, either or both, in the operations of said field, and to carry out the purposes of the statute.

In accordance with Rule 509, any interested party desiring to protest the granting of the application or to intervene on the application should file with the Commission a written protest or intervention no later than July 14, 2014, briefly stating the basis of the protest or intervention. One electronic, one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of July 14, 2014. Pursuant to Rule 503.g., if a party who has received notice under Rule 503.b. wishes to receive further pleadings in the above-referenced matter, that party must file a protest or intervention in accordance with these rules.
