APPLICATION

On May 29, 2014, Catamount Energy Partners LLC ("Catamount" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Pool all interests in an approximate 320-acre drilling and spacing unit established for the Application Lands, for the development and operation of the Fruitland coal seams; and
- 2) Subject any nonconsenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S., were first incurred for the drilling of the Carpenter 33-6-3 1S Well (API No. Pending).

- On June 17, 1988, Order No. 112-60 established 320-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of gas from the Fruitland coal seams.
- On July 11, 2000, Order No. 112-157 approved one additional well within each approximate 320-acre drilling and spacing unit for the production of gas from the Fruitland coal seams.
- On July 10, 2006, Order No. 112-190 approved up to four wells in each 320-acre drilling and spacing unit for the production of gas from the Fruitland coal seams.
