APPLICATION

On May 29, 2014, PDC Energy, Inc ("PDC" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Pool all interests in an approximate 160-acre designated wellbore spacing unit established for the Application Lands, for the development and operation of the Codell-Niobrara Formation; and
- 2) Subject any nonconsenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S., were first incurred for the drilling of the Purvis 10DD Well (API No. 05-123-32475).

PRIOR RULES AND ORDERS

- On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule.
- On February 19, 1992, Order No. 407-87 established 80-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations, within the permitted well locations in accordance with Order No. 407-1.
- On May 29, 2012, Order No. 407-656 pooled all interests in five approximate 80-acre designated wellbore spacing units and five approximate 160-acre designated wellbore spacing units in Section 10, Township 4 North, Range 67 West, 6th P.M., for the development and operation of the Codell and Niobrara Formations.
- On July 29, 2013, Order No. 407-818 pooled all interests in an approximate 160-acre designated wellbore spacing unit consisting in Sections 10 and 11, Township 4 North,

Range 67 West, 6th P.M., for the development and operation of the Codell-Niobrara Formation. Order No. 407-818 does not affect this Application.

- On September 16, 2013, Order No. 407-865 pooled all interests, including previously unnoticed interests, in an approximate 160-acre designated wellbore spacing unit established in Section 10, Township 4 North, Range 67 West, 6th P.M., for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation. Order No. 407-865 does not affect this Application.
- On December 16, 2013, Order No. 407-912 affirmed that all interests, including interests owned by previously unnoticed parties, were pooled, in an approximate 160-acre designated wellbore spacing unit established in Section 10 & 11, Township 4 North, Range 67 West, 6th P.M., pursuant to §34-60-116(6), C.R.S., by Order No. 407-818, for the development and operation of the Codell-Niobrara Formation.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, pursuant to: 1) the general jurisdiction granted to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado under §34-60-105 C.R.S.; 2) specific powers granted pursuant to §34-60-106 C.R.S.; 3) the State Administrative Procedures Act at §24-4-105 C.R.S.; and 4) the Commission's Series 500 Rules at 2 CCR 404-1, that the Commission has scheduled the above-entitled matter for hearing on:

One electronic (cogcc.hearings_unit@state.co.us), one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. **Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of July 14, 2014.** Pursuant to Rule 511., if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
