On May 29, 2014, Extraction Oil & Gas, LLC ("Extraction" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

1) Pool all interests in nine approximate 320-acre designated wellbore spacing units established for the Application Lands, for the development and operation of the Codell and Niobrara Formations; and

2) Subject all interests, including, but not limited to nonconsenting interests and leased mineral interests, to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S., were first incurred for the drilling of the Duck Club #1 Well in DWSU No. 1 (API No. Pending), the Duck Club #2 Well in DWSU No. 2 (API No. Pending), the Duck Club #3 Well in DWSU No. 3 (API No. Pending), the Duck Club #4 Well in DWSU No.4 (API No. Pending), the Duck Club #5 Well in DWSU No. 5 (API No. Pending), the Duck Club #6 Well in DWSU No. 6 (API No. Pending), the Duck Club #7 Well in DWSU No. 7 (API No. Pending), the Duck Club #8 Well in DWSU No. 8 (API No. Pending), and the Duck Club #9 Well in DWSU No. 9 (API No. Pending).

- On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule.
- On February 19, 1992, Order No. 407-87 established 80-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations, within the permitted well locations in accordance with Order No. 407-1.
