NOTICE OF HEARING

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Pursuant to Rule 522.c., the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission ("Commission" or "COGCC") Staff will apply to the Commission at its September 15-16, 2014 hearing for an Order Finding Violation ("OFV") against M E III Corporation (M E) (Operator No. 52060).

M E is the operator of the record for the Perry #1 and Perry #3 wells (API numbers: 123-09423 and 123-10324, respectively) both located in Weld County.

On July 23, 2013, the COGCC Enforcement Staff ("Staff") issued NOAV No. 200382926 to M E III citing violations of the COGCC Rules of Practice and Procedure, 2 CCR 404-1 ("Rule" or "Rules") for failure to file Operator's Monthly Report of Operations (Rule 309) and failure to file quarterly Conservation Levy Reports (Rule 310). At the time of the NOAV issuance, M E III had failed to file 48 Operator's Monthly Reports of Operations, and no conservation levy had been posted since the second quarter of 2006. Despite being sent to the address on record with the COGCC, the NOAV was returned to Staff as undeliverable.

This matter was originally noticed for the Commission's July 28-29, 2014 meeting. That notice was not published as required, so the matter is being re-noticed.

COGCC staff requests that M E be found in violation of Rule 309 and 310 and assessed a penalty pursuant to Rule 523.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, pursuant to: 1) the general jurisdiction granted to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado (Commission) under § 34-60-105 C.R.S.; 2) specific powers granted pursuant to § 34-60-106 C.R.S.; 3) the Colorado Administrative Procedures Act at § 24-4-105 C.R.S.; and 4) the Commission's Series 500 Rules at 2CCR 404-1, that the Commission has scheduled the above-entitled matter for hearing on:

In accordance with Rule 509, any interested party desiring to protest the granting of the application or to intervene on the application should file with the Commission a written protest or intervention no later than August 29, 2014, briefly stating the basis of the protest or intervention. An original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission along with an electronic version. Pursuant to Rule 503.g., if a party who has received notice under Rule 503.b. wishes to receive further pleadings in the above-referenced matter, that party must file a protest or intervention in accordance with these rules.
