NOTICE OF HEARING

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Pursuant to Rule 522.c., the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission ("Staff") will apply to the Commission at its September 15-16, 2014 hearing for an Order Finding Violation ("OFV") against Tekton Windsor LLC ("Tekton") (Operator No. 10392).

Tekton is the operator of record of the following wells ("Wells") in Weld County:

Pavistma South #1	API# 05-123-37703
Frye Farms #12	API# 05-123-38127

The Pavistma South #1 Well is located on the Pavistma South Pad (Location ID# 433139).

The Frye Farms #12 Well is located on the Frye Farms Pad (Location ID# 427354).

On August 20, 2013, Tekton spud the Pavistma South #1 Well without collecting a groundwater baseline sample and submitting the analytical results to the COGCC or submitting a Sundry Notice requesting exception to this rule as required by Rule 318Ae(4).

On October 17, 2013, Tekton spud the Frye Farms # 12 Well without collecting a groundwater baseline sample and submitting the analytical results to the COGCC or submitting a Sundry Notice requesting exception to this rule as required by Rule 318Ae(4).

On June 26, 2014, Commission staff issued Notices of Alleged Violation ("NOAV's") to Tekton. The NOAV's cited violations of the following COGCC Rules of Practice and Procedure, 2 CCR 404-1 ("Rule" or "Rules")

318Ae(4). (Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule - Groundwater Baseline Sampling and Monitoring)

Staff requests that Tekton be found in violation of the rule cited above and assessed a penalty pursuant to Rule 523.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, pursuant to: 1) the general jurisdiction granted to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado (Commission) under § 34-60-105 C.R.S.; 2) specific powers granted pursuant to § 34-60-106 C.R.S.; 3) the Colorado

Administrative Procedures Act at § 24-4-105 C.R.S.; and 4) the Commission's Series 500 Rules at 2CCR 404-1, that the Commission has scheduled the above-entitled matter for hearing on:



Pursuant to said hearing in the above-entitled matter at the time and place aforesaid, or at any adjourned meeting, the Commission will enter such orders as it deems appropriate to protect the health, safety and welfare of the public and to prevent the waste of oil and gas, either or both, in the operations of said field, and to carry out the purposes of the statute.

In accordance with Rule 509., any interested party desiring to protest the granting of the application or to intervene on the application should file with the Commission a written protest or intervention no later than August 29, 2014, briefly stating the basis of the protest or intervention. One electronic, one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of September 1, 2014. Pursuant to Rule 503.g., if a party who has received notice under Rule 503.b. wishes to receive further pleadings in the above-referenced matter, that party must file a protest or intervention in accordance with these rules.
