APPLICATION

On July 17, 2014, Bonanza Creek Energy LLC (“Bonanza” or “Applicant”) filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Vacate Order No. 407-539;
- 2) Establish an approximate 1280-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara and Codell Formations;
- 3) Approve up to four horizontal wells within the unit; and
- 4) Require the productive interval of the wellbore to be located no closer than 600 feet from the unit boundaries, and no closer than 150 feet from the productive interval of any other wellbore located in the unit, without exception by the Director.
- 5) Applicant requests that the proposed wells be located on no more than one well pad per quarter section, subject to Rule 318A.

- On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule.
- On January 23, 2012, Order No. 407-539 established an approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit for Section 20, Township 7 North, Range 62 West, 6th P.M., and approved up to two horizontal wells within the unit, for the production of oil, gas and

associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation. Section 20, Township 7 North, Range 62 West, 6th P.M. is subject to this Order.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, pursuant to: 1) the general jurisdiction granted to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado under §34-60-105 C.R.S.; 2) specific powers granted pursuant to §34-60-106 C.R.S.; 3) the State Administrative Procedures Act at §24-4-105 C.R.S.; and 4) the Commission's Series 500 Rules at 2 CCR 404-1, that the Commission has scheduled the above-entitled matter for hearing on:

One electronic (cogcc.hearings_unit@state.co.us), one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. **Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of August 29, 2014.** Pursuant to Rule 511., if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
