APPLICATION

On July 17, 2014, PDC Energy, Inc. ("PDC" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Pool all interests in an approximate 400-acre designated horizontal wellbore spacing unit established for the Application Lands, for the development and operation of the Niobrara Formation; and
- 2) Subject any nonconsenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S., were first incurred for the drilling of the Maxey 24Q-302 Well (API No. 05-123-37775).

- On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule.
- On February 19, 1992, Order No. 407-87 (amended August 20, 1993) established 80-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations, with the permitted well locations in accordance with the provisions of Order No. 407-1.
- On July 14, 2009, Order No. 407-334, established a wellbore spacing unit for Section 30, Township 5 North, Range 64 West, 6th P.M., and Section 25, Township 5 North, Range

65 West, 6th P.M., and pooled all nonconsenting interests in said unit, for the development and operation of the Codell and Niobrara Formations. Order No. 407-334 does not affect this Application.

- On March 17, 2014, Order No. 407-985 pooled all interests in an approximate 400-acre designated wellbore spacing unit established for Sections 19, 30, 24 and 25, Township 5 North, Ranges 64 and 65 West, 6th P.M., for the development and operation of the Codell-Niobrara Formation. Order No. 407-985 does not affect this Application.
- On March 17, 2014, Order No. 407-986 pooled all interests in an approximate 320-acre designated wellbore spacing unit established for Section 25, Township 5 North, Range 65 West, 6th P.M., for the development and operation of the Niobrara Formation. Order No. 407-986 does not affect this Application.
