APPLICATION

On August 28, 2014, Whiting Oil and Gas Corporation ("Whiting" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Vacate an approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit established by Order No. 535-42 for Section 17, Township 9 North, Range 57 West, 6th P.M.;
- 2) Establish an approximate 960-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara and Codell Formations:
 - 3) Approve up to 32 horizontal wells within the unit;
- 4) Require the productive interval of the wellbore to be located no closer than 100 feet from the unit boundaries, and no closer than 100 feet from the productive interval of any other wellbore located in the unit; and
- 5) Applicant requests that the wells are drilled from no more than eight well pads within the unit.

 Rule 318.a. of the Rules and Regulations of the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission requires that, on unspaced lands, wells drilled in excess of 2,500 feet in depth be located not less than 600 feet from any lease line, and located not less than 1,200 feet from any other producible or drilling oil or gas well when drilling to the same common source of supply. The Application Lands are subject to Rule 318.a for the Codell Formation.

- On June 27, 2011, Order No. 535-42 established eight approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing units and approved one horizontal well within each unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation. Sections 8 and 17, Township 9 North, Range 57 West, 6th P.M. are subject to this Order for the Niobrara Formation.
- On April 28, 2014, Order No. 535-481 vacated two approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing units established by Order No. 535-42, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation.. Section 8, Township 9 North, Range 57 West, 6th P.M. is subject to this Order for the Niobrara Formation.
