On August 28, 2014, PDC Energy, Inc. ("PDC" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Pool all interests in an approximate 80-acre drilling and spacing unit established for the Application Lands, for the development and operation of the Codell-Niobrara Formation; and
- 2) Subject any nonconsenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S., were first incurred for the drilling of the Wells Ranch 31-2 Well (API No. 05-123-23182).

- On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule.
- On February 19, 1992, Order No. 407-87 (amended August 20, 1993) established 80-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations, with the permitted well locations in accordance with the provisions of Order No. 407-1.
- On March 17, 2014, Order No. 407-987 pooled all interests in two approximate 317-acre designated wellbore spacing units established for Section 2, Township 5 North, Range 63 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., for the development and operation of the Codell-Niobrara Formation. Order No. 407-987 does not affect this Application.
