- 1) Pool all interests in an approximate 480-acre designated horizontal wellbore spacing unit established for the Application Lands, effective as of the date of the Application, for the development and operation of the Niobrara Formation; and
- 2) Subject any nonconsenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., for the drilling of the Hunziker 28N-4HZ Well (API No. 05-123-40889).


