On December 22, 2014, EOG Resources, Inc. (Operator No. 27442) ("EOG" or "Applicant") filed a verified application (amended March 19, 2015) pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Establish 11 approximate 1280-acre drilling and spacing units for the Application Lands, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell Formation;
 - 2) Approve up to six horizontal wells within each unit; and
- 3) Require the productive interval of the wellbore to be located no closer than 460 feet from the unit boundaries, and no closer than 150 feet from the productive interval of any other wellbore located in the unit.

 Rule 318.a. of the Rules and Regulations of the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission requires that, on unspaced lands, wells drilled in excess of 2,500 feet in depth be located not less than 600 feet from any lease line, and located not less than 1,200 feet from any other producible or drilling oil or gas well when drilling to the same common source of supply.
