1) Modify Commission Order No. 547-7 well location rules for the 473-acre exploratory drilling unit established for the Application Lands, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Sego, Mancos, Niobrara, Frontier, Mowry and Dakota Formations ("Deep Formations"), to allow the treated interval of any permitted well to be located no closer than 300 feet from the northern and southern unit boundaries, and not less than 150 feet from any other well or treated interval of a well producing from the same source of supply.

• On March 17, 2014, the Commission entered Order No. 547-7 which, among other things, established an approximate 473-acre exploratory drilling unit for the Application Lands, and approved up to twenty (20) horizontal, vertical or directional wells to be drilled therein, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Deep Formations, with the treated interval of the permitted wellbore(s) to be located no closer than 600 feet from the outer boundaries of the unit, and not less than 300 feet from any other well or treated interval of a well producing from the same common source of supply, without exception from the Director.
