APPLICATION

On February 12, 2015 (Amended April 10, 2015), EE3 LLC, Operator No. 10450 ("EE3" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

1) Allow 300 foot setbacks as to the unit boundaries of the Surprise Federal Exploratory Unit, composed of the Application Lands, for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation.

- On February 25, 2008 the Commission entered Order No. 531-1, which among other things, established various drilling and spacing units for the drilling and completion of one horizontal well, with the option to drill a second horizontal well in each of the drilling and spacing units, with the permitted wells to be located no closer than 600 feet from the unit boundary, for certain lands in Townships 6 and 7 North, Range 80 West, 6th P.M., for the production of gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation. Section 4, Township 6 North, Range 80 West, 6th P.M. is subject to Order No. 531-1 for the Niobrara Formation.
- On July 15, 2008 the Commission entered Order No. 531-2, which extended the provisions of Order No. 531-1 to additional lands. The effect of such extension was to establish various drilling and spacing units for the drilling and completion of one horizontal well, with the option to drill a second horizontal well in each of the drilling and spacing units, with the permitted wells to be located no closer than 600 feet from the unit boundary, for certain lands in Townships 6 and 7 North, Range 80 West, 6th P.M., for the production of gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation. Sections 7, 8, 9, 16, 17 and 18, Township 6 North, Range 80 West, 6th P.M. are subject to Order No. 531-2 for the Niobrara Formation.
- Rule 318.a. of the Rules and Regulations of the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission requires that wells drilled in excess of 2,500 feet in depth be located not less than 600 feet from any lease line, and located not less than 1,200 feet

from any other producible or drilling oil or gas well when drilling to the same common source of supply. The remaining Application Lands not subject to Order Nos. 531-1 or 531-2 are subject to Rule 318.a. for the Niobrara Formation.
