NOTICE AND APPLICATION FOR HEARING

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Pursuant to Rule 522.e.(2), the Colorado Oil and Gas Conservation Commission ("Commission" or "COGCC") Staff will apply to the Commission at its May 18 & 19, 2015 hearing for an Order Finding Violation ("OFV") against Benchmark Energy LLC ("Benchmark") (Operator No. 10380). This Notice and Application is being served to adjudicate the allegations made in the below-described Notices of Alleged Violation ("NOAVs"), the allegations of which are incorporated herein.

Benchmark is the operator of the following Wells in Logan County: Logan J Sand Unit 2-5 Well (API No. 05-075-06004), Mount Hope Green 4 Well (API No. 05-075-06464), Mount Hope Unit 49 Well (API No. 05-075-06343), NW Graylin D Sand Unit 8 Well (API No. 05-075-06002), NW Graylin D Sand Unit 9 Well (API No. 05-075-06016), and NW Graylin D Sand Unit 12 Well (API No. 05-075-06129).

On July 23, 2014, COGCC Staff inspected these Wells and observed violations of Commission rules. On November 18, 2014, follow-up inspections determined that none of the violations listed below had been corrected.

On January 15, 2015, COGCC Staff issued NOAV Nos. 200421709, 200421712, 200421713, 200421714, 200421715, and 200421716 for violations at the above listed Wells of the following COGCC Rules of Practice and Procedure, 2 CCR 404-1 ("Rule" or "Rules"):

- a. Rule 210 (Signs & Markers);
- b. Rule 603.f. (Equipment, Weeds, Waste, & Trash);
- c. Rule 605.a.(4) (Berms);
- d. Rule 605.d. (Mechanical Conditions);
- e. Rule 906.a. (Spills & Releases, General);
- f. Rule 1002.f. (Stormwater Management); and
- g. Rule 1003.a. (Interim Reclamation, General).

COGCC staff requests that Benchmark be found in violation of rules cited above and assessed a penalty pursuant to Rule 523.
