APPLICATION

On March 19, 2015, Kerr-McGee Oil & Gas Onshore LP (Operator No. 47120) ("Kerr-McGee" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

1) Modify Order No. 407-962, which pools all interests in an approximate 480-acre designated horizontal wellbore spacing unit for the drilling of the McKinstry 28N-21HZ Well (API No. 05-123-37009). Applicant requests to modify the acreage calculation of the wellbore spacing unit found in Order No. 407-962 from 480 acres, to 560 acres. Specifically, Applicant requests to include the SW¼SW¼ of Section 14, and the NW¼NW¼ of Section 23, Township 3 North, Range 68 West, 6th P.M., to Order No. 407-962. The modified Application Lands, as defined below, will comprise 560 acres and allow for the development of the Niobrara Formation.

Upon review of the Application, the Commission may require that Applicant treat the requested modification to the wellbore spacing units as a vacation of the previous wellbore spacing units and request to pool the new unit upon review of testimony submitted in support of the Application.

- On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule.
- On February 19, 1992, the Commission entered Order No. 407-87 (amended August 20, 1993) which, among other things, established 80-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation underlying certain lands, including the Application Lands, with the permitted well locations in accordance with the provisions of Order No. 407-1.
- On March 17, 2014, the Commission entered Order No. 407-962, which among other things, approves the request for an order to pool all interests, including leased mineral interests, in an approximate 480-acre designated wellbore spacing unit established for certain lands in Sections 15, 16, 21 and 22, Township 3 North, Range 68 West, 6th P.M., for the development and operation of the Niobrara Formation. Applicant is requesting modification of Order No. 407-962.
