On March 19, 2015, Extraction Oil & Gas LLC (Operator No. 10459) ("Extraction" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

1) Pool all interests in three approximate 319.21-acre designated horizontal wellbore spacing units ("WSU") established for the Application Lands for the development and operation of the Codell and Niobrara Formations; and

2) Subject any nonconsenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S., were first incurred for the drilling of the Rancho Water Valley #4 Well (API No. 05-123-36434) (WSU #1), Water Valley #6 Well (API No. 05-123-36433) (WSU #2) and the Water Valley #7 Well (API No. 05-123-36429) (WSU #3).
