APPLICATION

On May 21, 2015, Kerr-McGee Oil & Gas Onshore LP, Operator No. 47120 ("Kerr-McGee" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

1) Pool all interests in three approximate 240-acre to 400-acre designated wellbore spacing units, established for the Application Lands, for the development and operation of the Codell and Niobrara Formations; and

2) Subject any nonconsenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S., were first incurred for the drilling of the Carter 14N-33HZ Well (API No. Pending) (WSU #1), the Carter 14C-33HZ Well (API No. Pending) (WSU #2), and the Carter 36N-33HZ Well (API No. Pending) (WSU #3).
