APPLICATION

On May 21, 2015, Great Western Operating Company, LLC (Operator No. 10110) ("Great Western" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S. for an order to:

- 1) Pool all interests in two approximate 320-acre designated horizontal wellbore spacing units, for the development and operation of the Niobrara Formation.
- 2) Subject any non-consenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S. were first incurred for the drilling of the Chandler Farms HD 20-212HN Well (API No. 05-123-41360), or the Chandler Farms HD 20-229HN Well (API No. 05-123-41365) to the Niobrara Formation.

- On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule.
- On February 19, 1992 (amended August 20, 1993), the Commission entered Order No. 407-87 which established 80-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara and Codell Formations, with the permitted well locations in accordance with the provisions of Order No. 407-1.
- On July 29, 2013, the Commission entered Order No. 407-817 which pooled all interests in three approximate 160-acre designated wellbore spacing units consisting of certain lands in Sections 17 and 20, Township 4 North, Range 67 West, 6th P.M., for the development and operation of the Codell-Niobrara Formation.

- On March 17, 2014, the Commission entered Order No. 407-974 which pooled all interests in an approximate 160-acre designated wellbore spacing unit established for certain lands in Sections 19 and 20, Township 4 North, Range 67 West, 6th P.M., for the development and operation of the Codell-Niobrara Formation.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, pursuant to: 1) the general jurisdiction granted to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado under §34-60-105 C.R.S.; 2) specific powers granted pursuant to §34-60-106 C.R.S.; 3) the State Administrative Procedures Act at §24-4-105 C.R.S.; and 4) the Commission's Series 500 Rules at 2 CCR 404-1, that the Commission has scheduled the above-entitled matter for hearing on:

One electronic (cogcc.hearings_unit@state.co.us), one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. **Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of July 6, 2015.** Pursuant to Rule 511, if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing, based on review of the merits of the verified application and supporting exhibits.
