

## Training for Implementing the Interim Policy for APDs

The COGCC staff will conduct training on its interim policy for APDs submitted between January 1, 2009 and the effective date of the rule amendments. The policy will require operators to identify permit applications that are in (1) drinking water protection areas; (2) restricted surface occupancy areas; (3) sensitive wildlife habitat areas; and (4) areas within 300' of streams west of Interstate 25. This training will cover the following topics:

How to identify permits that fall within these areas

1. Use of the COGCC GIS Online to identify
  - a. Drinking water protection areas
  - b. restricted surface occupancy areas
  - c. sensitive wildlife habitat areas
  - d. areas within 300' of streams west of Interstate 25
2. Non- mapping search tool
3. What spatial data is available for download for use in in-house mapping systems
4. How to indicate that the permit is within one of these protective areas
5. What the COGCC will do with this information
