APPLICATION

Bayswater Exploration & Production, LLC ("Bayswater" or "Applicant"), Operator No. 10261, by and through its attorneys, Welborn Sullivan Meck & Tooley, P.C., respectfully submits this Application to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado ("Commission" or "COGCC") for an order pooling all interests in (1) two approximate 640-acre horizontal wellbore spacing units ("WSU") covering the N½S½, S½N½ of Sections 19 and 20; (2) two approximate 320-acre WSUs covering the N½S½ of Sections 19 and 20; (4) two approximate 320-acre WSUs covering the S½S½ of Sections 19 and 20; and (5) two approximate 640-acre WSUs covering the S½S½ of Sections 19 and 20 and the N½N½ of Sections 29 and 30, all in Township 6 North, Range 66 West, 6th P.M., Weld County, Colorado for development and production from the Niobrara (WSU Nos. 1, 3, 4, 6, 7, 9, 10, and 12) and Codell (WSU Nos. 2, 5, 8, and 11) Formations. In support thereof, the Applicant states as follows:

- 1. Applicant is a limited liability company duly authorized to conduct business in the State of Colorado.
- 2. Applicant owns a leasehold interest in the WSUs comprised of the following lands ("Application Lands"):

- 3. Rule 318A.a.(4)D. provides, in relevant part, that where a drilling and spacing unit does not exist for a horizontal well, the horizontal wellbore spacing unit shall be comprised of the governmental quarter-quarter sections in which the wellbore lateral penetrates the productive formation as well as any governmental quarter-quarter sections that are located less than four hundred sixty (460) feet from the portion of the wellbore lateral that penetrates the productive zone regardless of section or quarter section lines. Rule 318A.a.(4)D. further provides that a horizontal wellbore spacing unit may overlap portions of another horizontal wellbore spacing unit or other wellbore spacing unit designated in accordance with subsection a.(4)C. The Application Lands are subject to this Rule for the Codell and Niobrara Formations.
- 4. Applicant drilled the following wells in the Application Lands, each of which is located in a separate Horizontal Wellbore Spacing Unit ("WSU") established pursuant to Rule 318A.

- (a) **WSU No. 1**: Ward M-20-19HN well (API# 05-123-43655), estimated spud date June 15, 2017. The above-described horizontal well is designed to test and produce gas and associated hydrocarbons from the **Niobrara Formation** underlying the Application Lands.
- (b) **WSU No. 2**: Ward N-20-19HC well (API# 05-123-43661), estimated spud date June 15, 2017. The above-described horizontal well is designed to test and produce gas and associated hydrocarbons from the **Codell Formation** underlying the Application Lands.
- (c) **WSU No. 3**: Ward O-20-19HN well (API# 05-123-43657), estimated spud date June 15, 2017. The above-described horizontal well is designed to test and produce gas and associated hydrocarbons from the **Niobrara Formation** underlying the Application Lands.
- (d) **WSU No. 4**: Ward P-20-19HN well (API# 05-123-43658), estimated spud date June 15, 2017. The above-described horizontal well is designed to test and produce gas and associated hydrocarbons from the **Niobrara Formation** underlying the Application Lands.
- (e) **WSU No. 5**: Ward Q-20-19HC well (API# 05-123-43659), estimated spud date June 15, 2017. The above-described horizontal well is designed to test and produce gas and associated hydrocarbons from the **Codell Formation** underlying the Application Lands.
- (f) **WSU No. 6**: Ward R-20-19HN well (API# 05-123-43662), estimated spud date June 15, 2017. The above-described horizontal well is designed to test and produce gas and associated hydrocarbons from the **Niobrara Formation** underlying the Application Lands.
- (g) **WSU No. 7**: Ward S-20-19HN well (API# 05-123-43660), estimated spud date June 15, 2017. The above-described horizontal well is designed to test and produce gas and associated hydrocarbons from the **Niobrara Formation** underlying the Application Lands.
- (h) **WSU No. 8**: Ward T-20-19HC well (API# 05-123-43656), estimated spud date June 15, 2017. The above-described horizontal well is designed to test and produce gas and associated hydrocarbons from the **Codell Formation** underlying the Application Lands.
- (i) **WSU No. 9**: Ward U-20-19HN well (API# 05-123-43653), estimated spud date June 15, 2017. The above-described horizontal well is designed to test and produce gas and associated hydrocarbons from the **Niobrara Formation** underlying the Application Lands.
- (j) WSU No. 10: Ward V-20-19HN well (API# 05-123-43651), estimated spud date June 15, 2017. The above-described horizontal well is designed to test and

produce gas and associated hydrocarbons from the **Niobrara Formation** underlying the Application Lands.

- (k) **WSU No. 11**: Ward W-20-19HC well (API# 05-123-43654), estimated spud date June 15, 2017. The above-described horizontal well is designed to test and produce gas and associated hydrocarbons from the **Codell Formation** underlying the Application Lands.
- (I) **WSU No. 12**: Ward X-20-19HN well (API# 05-123-43652), estimated spud date June 15, 2017. The above-described horizontal well is designed to test and produce gas and associated hydrocarbons from the **Niobrara Formation** underlying the Application Lands.

(collectively, the "Ward Wells").

- 5. Pursuant to the relevant provisions of Section 34-60-116(6) & (7), C.R.S., and COGCC Rule 530, Applicant seeks an order pooling all interests in the Application Lands for the development and operation of the Niobrara Formation in WSU Nos. 1, 3, 4, 6, 7, 9, 10, and 12 and for the development and operation of the Codell Formation in WSU Nos. 2, 5, 8, and 11.
- 6. Applicant requests that a pooling order be entered as a result of this Application and that it be made effective as of the earlier of the date of this Application, or the date costs specified in Section 34-60-116(7)(b)(II), C.R.S., are first incurred for the drilling of each of the Ward Wells, in or with respect to each separate WSU.
- 7. The granting of this Application would be in accord with the Oil and Gas Conservation Act, found at Section 34-60-101, *et seq.*, C.R.S., and Commission rules.
- 8. The names of the interested parties (persons who own an interest in the mineral estate of the tracts to be pooled, except owners of overriding royalty interest) are attached hereto and identified on Exhibit A. Applicant certifies that copies of this Application will be served on all locatable interested parties within seven (7) days of the date hereof, as required by Commission Rule 507.b(2), and that at least thirty-five (35) days prior to the date of the scheduled protest deadline for this Application, each such owner, which Applicant was able to locate, not already leased or voluntarily pooled will be offered the opportunity to lease or to participate and bear costs associated with the drilling and completion of the Ward Wells, and will be provided with well proposals containing the information required by Rule 530.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that this matter be set for hearing, that notice be given as required by law and that upon such hearing this Commission enter its order:

A. Pooling all interests in the Application Lands for the development and operation of the Niobrara Formation in WSU Nos. 1, 3, 4, 6, 7, 9, 10, and 12 and the Codell Formation in WSU Nos. 2, 5, 8, and 11.

B. Providing that the pooling order is made effective as of the date of this Application, or the date that the costs specified in Section 34-60-116(7)(b)(II), C.R.S., are first incurred for the drilling of the following wells in the following horizontal wellbore spacing units:

WSU No. 1 – Ward M-20-19HN well (API# 05-123-43655) – Niobrara Formation WSU No. 2 – Ward N-20-19HC well (API# 05-123-43661) – Codell Formation WSU No. 3 – Ward O-20-19HN well (API# 05-123-43657) – Niobrara Formation WSU No. 4 – Ward P-20-19HN well (API# 05-123-43658) – Niobrara Formation WSU No. 5 – Ward Q-20-19HC well (API# 05-123-43659) – Codell Formation WSU No. 6 – Ward R-20-19HN well (API# 05-123-43662) – Niobrara Formation WSU No. 7 – Ward S-20-19HN well (API# 05-123-43660) – Niobrara Formation WSU No. 8 – Ward T-20-19HC well (API# 05-123-43656) – Codell Formation WSU No. 9 – Ward U-20-19HN well (API# 05-123-43651) – Niobrara Formation WSU No. 10 – Ward V-20-19HN well (API# 05-123-43654) – Codell Formation WSU No. 11 – Ward W-20-19HN well (API# 05-123-43652) – Niobrara Formation WSU No. 12 – Ward X-20-19HN well (API# 05-123-43652) – Niobrara Formation

- C. Providing that the interests of any owners, with whom the Applicant has been unable to secure a lease or other agreement to participate in the drilling of the authorized well, are pooled by operation of statute, pursuant to Section 34-60-116(7), C.R.S., and made subject to the cost recovery provisions thereof.
- D. For such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable in the Application Lands.
