APPLICATION

Extraction Oil & Gas, Inc. (Extraction or Applicant), Operator No. 10459, by its attorneys, Welborn Sullivan Meck & Tooley, P.C., respectfully submits this Application to the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission of the State of Colorado (Commission) for an order pooling all interests in five approximate 320-acre horizontal wellbore spacing units (WSU) established for the E½ of Section 5, Township 5 North, Range 65 West, 6th P.M., for the development and production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara and Codell Formations. In support thereof, the Applicant states as follows:

- 1. Applicant is a corporation duly authorized to conduct business in the State of Colorado and a registered operator in good standing with the Commission.
- 2. Applicant owns a leasehold interest in the following lands (Application Lands):

Township 5 North, Range 65 West, 6th P.M. Section 5: E½

A reference map of the Application Lands is attached hereto.

3. On April 27, 1988, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule, which was amended on August 8, 2011 to, among other things, address the drilling of horizontal wells. Rule 318A.a.(4)D. provides, in relevant part, that where a drilling and spacing unit does not exist for a horizontal well, the horizontal wellbore spacing unit shall be comprised of the governmental quarter-quarter sections in which the wellbore lateral penetrates the productive formation as well as any governmental quarter-quarter

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sections that are located less than four hundred sixty (460) feet from the portion of the wellbore lateral that penetrates the productive zone regardless of section or quarter section lines. Rule 318A.a.(4)D. further provides that a horizontal wellbore spacing unit may overlap portions of another horizontal wellbore spacing unit or other wellbore spacing unit designated in accordance with subsection a.(4)C. The Application Lands are subject to this Rule.

- 4. Applicant has permitted, and plans to drill and complete the following wells on their respective WSUs covering the Application Lands in the corresponding formation:
 - a. **WSU No. 1:** WS-Sunrise 1-5-5 well (API No. 05-123-46047), with an estimated spud date 1st-2nd quarter 2018, to produce oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation; and
 - b. **WSU No. 2:** WS-Sunrise 2-5-5well (API No. 05-123-46048), with an estimated spud date 1st-2nd quarter 2018, to produce oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation;
 - c. **WSU No. 3:** WS-Sunrise C1-5-5 well (API No. 05-123-46045), with an estimated spud date 1st-2nd quarter 2018, to produce oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell Formation; and
 - d. **WSU No. 4:** WS-Sunrise 4-5-5 well (API No. 05-123-46049), with an estimated spud date 1st-2nd quarter 2018, to produce oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation; and
 - e. **WSU No. 5:** WS-Sunrise 5-5-5 well (API No. 05-123-46052), with an estimated spud date 1st-2nd quarter 2018, to produce oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation.

Hereinafter, the Wells.

- 5. Pursuant to the relevant provisions of Section 34-60-116(6) & (7), C.R.S., and COGCC Rule 530, Applicant seeks an order pooling all interests in the Application Lands for the development and operation of the Niobrara and Codell Formations in WSU Nos. 1 -5.
- 6. Applicant requests that the order entered as a result of this Application be made effective retroactive to the date of this Application or the date that the costs specified in Section 34-60-116(7), C.R.S., were first incurred for the drilling of the Wells, whichever is earlier.
- 7. The granting of this Application would be in accord with the Oil and Gas Conservation Act, found at Section 34-60-101, et seq., C.R.S., and Commission rules.

8. The names and addresses of the interested parties (persons who own an interest in the mineral estate of the tracts to be pooled, except owners of overriding royalty interest) are attached hereto and marked Exhibit A. Applicant certifies that copies of this Application will be served on all locatable interested parties within seven (7) days of the date hereof, as required by Commission Rule 507.b.(2), and that at least thirty-five (35) days prior to the date of the scheduled protest deadline for this Application, each such owner not already leased or voluntarily pooled will be offered the opportunity to lease, or to participate in the drilling of the Wells, or both, as applicable, and will be provided with the information required by Rule 530.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that this matter be set for hearing, that notice be given as required by law and that upon such hearing this Commission enter its order:

- A. Pooling all interests in the Application Lands for the development and operation of the Niobrara Formation in WSU Nos. 1, 2, 4, and 5, and for the development and operation of the Codell Formation in WSU No. 3.
- B. Providing that the pooling order is made effective as of the date of this Application, or the date that the costs specified in Section 34-60-116(7)(b)(II), C.R.S., are first incurred for the drilling of the Wells on the Application Lands, whichever is earlier;
- C. Providing that the interests of any owners, with whom the Applicant has been unable to secure a lease or other agreement to participate in the drilling of the Wells, are pooled by operation of statute, pursuant to Section 34-60-116(7), C.R.S., and made subject to the cost recovery provisions thereof;
- D. For such other findings and orders as the Commission may deem proper or advisable in the premises.



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
