On May 22, 2015, Foundation Energy Fund III-A, L.P., Foundation Energy Fund III-B Holding, L.L.C., Foundation Energy Fund IV-A, L.P., and Foundation Energy Fund IV-B Holding, L.L.C., by and through Foundation Energy Management, L.L.C., as manager of each of these four entities ("Foundation" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-118, C.R.S., for an order to:

1) Establish an approximate 440-acre enhanced recovery unit for the Application Lands and approve unitization and unitized operation for the production of oil, gas, and associated hydrocarbons from the "D" Sand formation in the Greasewood Field 32300 and Greasewood South Field 32700.



Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of July 6, 2015. Pursuant to Rule 511., if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
