APPLICATION

On July 16, 2015, Crescent Point Energy U.S. Corp. ("CPEUSC" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Vacate an approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit established by Order No. 535-69;
- 2) Vacate an approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit established by Order No. 535-86;
- 3) Establish an approximate 960-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara and Codell Formations;
- 4) Approve up to 28 horizontal wells within the unit;
- 5) Require the productive interval of the wellbore of any permitted wells to be located no closer than 460 feet from the unit boundaries, and no closer than 150 feet from the productive interval of any other wellbore located in each unit; and
- 6) Applicant requests that the wells are drilled from no more than four well pads within the unit.

- On September 19, 2011, the Commission entered Order No. 535-69, which, among other things, established an approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit comprised of All of Section 32, Township 9 North, Range 59 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., and approved up to two horizontal wells within the unit, for production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation.
- On October 31, 2011, the Commission entered Order No. 535-86, which, among other things, established an approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit comprised of All of Section 5, Township 8 North, Range 59 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., and approved up to two horizontal wells within the unit, for production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation.

Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of October 12, 2015. Pursuant to Rule 511, if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing, based on review of the merits of the verified application and supporting exhibits.
