APPLICATION

On October 8, 2015, Petroshare Corp. ("Petroshare" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to § 34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Establish the Application Lands as an approximate 400-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Niobrara and Codell Formations;
- 2) Authorize the drilling and completion of up to seven horizontal wells in the proposed drilling and spacing unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara and Codell Formations;
- 3) Authorize the productive interval for any of the horizontal wells drilled and completed within the proposed drilling and spacing unit to be located no closer than one hundred fifty feet (150') from the productive interval of any other horizontal wellbore located within the proposed drilling and spacing unit, absent exception being granted by the Director or variance being granted by the Commission, pursuant to Commission Rule 503.b.(1); and
- 4) Authorize the productive interval for any of the horizontal wells drilled and completed within the proposed drilling and spacing unit to be located no closer than four hundred sixty feet (460') from the boundary of the proposed drilling and spacing unit, absent exception being granted by the Director or variance being granted by the Commission.
