- Rule 318.a. of the Rules and Regulations of the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission requires that, on unspaced lands, wells drilled in excess of 2,500 feet in depth be located not less than 600 feet from any lease line, and located not less than 1,200 feet from any other producible or drilling oil or gas well when drilling to the same common source of supply. The Unit Area is subject to Rule 318.a. for the Target Formation.

Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of November 23, 2015. Pursuant to Rule 511., if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
