APPLICATION

On November 25, 2015, Angus Natural Resources, LLC (Operator No. 10423) ("Angus"), filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

1) Pool all interests an approximate 240-acre drilling and spacing unit proposed for the Application Lands, for development and operation of the Spergen, St. Louis, Warsaw, and Osage Formations of Mississippian age and the Morrow, Shawnee, Marmaton, Fort Scott and Lansing-Kansas City Formations of Pennsylvanian age; and

2) Subject any nonconsenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S., were first incurred for the drilling of the Hair 15-45 #1-14 Well.

- Rule 318.a. specifies that a well drilled to a depth of two thousand five hundred (2,500) feet or greater shall be located not less than six hundred (600) feet from any lease line.

Pursuant to Rule 511., if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
