APPLICATION

On November 25, 2015, Ward Petroleum Corporation ("Ward" or "Applicant"), by its attorneys, filed with the Commission pursuant to §34-60-116 C.R.S., a verified application ("Application") for an order to:

- 1) Pool all interests in an established 640-acre drilling and spacing unit, for the development and operation of the Niobrara and Codell Formations.
- 2) Subject any non-consenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S. were first incurred for the drilling of the Anderson 18-3-9HC well, the Anderson 18-3-11HC well, and the Anderson 18-3-10HN well.

- On December 15, 2014, the Commission entered Order No. 1412-SP-2225, establishing the Section 18, Township 1 South, Range 66 West, 6th P.M. as a 640-acre drilling and spacing unit for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations, and approved up to 12 horizontal wells in the Unit.


Additional information about the hearing on this Application will be in the Commission's Agenda, which is posted on the Commission website approximately 3 days before the hearing.

Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a prehearing conference during the week of January 12, 2016. Pursuant to Rule 511., if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
