On January 7, 2016, Verdad Oil & Gas Corporation, Operator No. 10485 ("Verdad" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Establish an approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation; and
 - 2) Authorize the drilling of up to eight (8) horizontal wells within the proposed unit.
- 3) For any permitted wells to be drilled under this Application for production from the Niobrara Formation, the treated intervals of the wellbore shall be no closer than 460 feet from unit boundaries, and no closer than 150 feet from the productive interval of any other wellbore located in the unit, without exception being granted by the Director.
- 4) Applicant states that the proposed wells shall be located on no more than three multi-well pads subject to Rule 318A, unless an exception is granted by the Director.
