APPLICATION

On January 7, 2016, Kerr-McGee Oil & Gas Onshore LP, Operator No. 47120 ("Kerr-McGee" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

1) Pool all interests in five approximate 480-acre horizontal wellbore spacing units, one approximate 400-acre horizontal wellbore spacing unit, and one approximate 240-acre horizontal wellbore spacing unit established for the Application Lands, for the development and operation of the Codell and Niobrara Formations; and

2) Subject any nonconsenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date that any of the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S., were first incurred for the drilling of the Land Fed 34C-32HZ Well (API No. 05-123-42395) – Codell Formation (WSU No. 1); the Land Fed 34N-32HZ Well (API No. 05-123-42396) – Niobrara Formation (WSU No. 2); the Land Fed 13N-32HZ Well (API No. 05-123-42400) – Niobrara Formation (WSU No. 3); the Land Fed 35C-32HZ Well (API No. 05-123-42397) – Codell Formation (WSU No. 4); the Land Fed 3N-32HZ Well (API No. 05-123-42390) – Niobrara Formation (WSU No. 5); the Land Fed 13S-32HZ (API No. 05-123-42391) – Sussex Formation (WSU No. 6) and the Land 14N-32HZ Well (API No. 05-123-42389) – Niobrara Formation – (WSU No. 7) ("Wells").
