- 1) Pool all interests in six approximate 480-acre horizontal wellbore spacing units, for the development and operation of the Codell and Niobrara Formations; and
- 2) Subject any nonconsenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of §34-60-116(7), C.R.S., effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the date that any of

the costs specified in §34-60-116(7)(b), C.R.S., were first incurred for the drilling of the Land Fed 30C-29HZ Well (API No. 05-123-42401) (WSU No. 1); the Land Fed 30N-29HZ Well (API No. 05-123-42398) (WSU No. 2); the Land Fed 29C-29HZ Well (API No. 05-123-42399) (WSU No. 3); the Land Fed 29N-29HZ Well (API No. 05-123-42393) (WSU No. 4); the Land Fed 35N-29HZ (API No. 05-123-42392) (WSU No. 5); and the Land 28N-29HZ Well (API No. 05-123-42394) (WSU No. 6) ("Wells").
