 - (a) The date on which payment of proceeds is due a payee under section (2) of the section;
 - (b) The existence or nonexistence of an occurrence pursuant to subsection (3) of this section which would justifiably cause a delay in payment; and
 - (c) The amount of the proceeds plus interest, if any due a payee or payor.
- Section 34-60-118.5(2)(a), C.R.S., provides that payment of proceeds derived from the sale
 of oil, gas, or associated products shall be paid by a payor to the payee commencing not
 later than six months after the end of the month in which production is first sold, and,
 thereafter, on a monthly basis not later than sixty days for oil and ninety days for gas and

associated products following the end of the calendar month in which subsequent production is sold.
