APPLICATION

On February 18, 2016, Bill Barrett Corporation, Operator No. 10071 ("BBC" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

1) Establish an approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit for all of Sections 4 and 5, Township 3 North, Range 62 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., and approving up to sixteen (16) horizontal wells within the unit for production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation (DSU No. 1);

2) Establish an approximate 1,280-acre drilling and spacing unit for all of Sections 4 and 5, Township 3 North, Range 62 West, 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., and approving up to four (4) horizontal wells within the unit for production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell Formation (DSU No. 2);

3) For any permitted wells to be drilled under this Application for production from the Codell or Niobrara Formations, the treated intervals of the wellbore shall be no closer than 460 feet from unit boundaries, and no closer than 150 feet from the productive interval of any other wellbore located in the unit, without exception being granted by the Director.

4) Applicant states that the wells will be drilled from no more than four multi-well pads.
