APPLICATION

On February 18, 2016, Caerus WashCo LLC ("Caerus" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to § 34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Establish an approximate 1280-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara and Codell Formations;
- 2) Approve up to twenty-eight horizontal wells within the unit, with twenty-four horizontal wells to be drilled to the Niobrara Formation and four horizontal wells to be drilled to the Codell Formation, with the productive interval of each wellbore located no closer than 460 feet from the unit boundaries, and no closer than 100 feet from the productive interval of any other wellbore located within the unit, without exception being granted by the Director
- 3) Applicant states that the proposed wells will be located on no more than four wellpads within the unit or on adjacent lands, without exception granted by the Director.
