1) Pool all interests in two approximate 320-acre and six approximate 640-acre horizontal wellbore spacing units established for the Application Lands, for the development and operation of the Niobrara and Codell Formations; and

2) Subject any nonconsenting interests to the cost recovery provisions of § 34-60-116(7), C.R.S. effective as of the earlier of the date of the Application, or the drilling of the Loloff Farms 26G-432 well (API No. 05-123-40383), the Loloff Farms 26G-232 well (API No. 05-123-40382), the Loloff Farms 26H-312ST well (API No. 05-123-40376), the Loloff Farms 26H-202ST well (API No. 05-123-40379), the Loloff Farms 26H-332 well (API No. 05-123-40514), the Loloff Farms 26H-232 well (API No. 05-123-40510), the Loloff Farms 26i-312 well (API No. 05-123-40513), and the Loloff Farms 26i-402 well (API No. 05-123-40516).

- On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule.
- On February 19, 1992 (amended August 20, 1993), the Commission entered Order No. 407-87 which established 80-acre drilling and spacing units for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara and Codell Formations, with the permitted well locations in accordance with the provisions of Order No. 407-1.
