NOTICE OF HEARING

TO ALL INTERESTED PARTIES AND TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

3.30 acres, more or less, Garfield County, Colorado.

APPLICATION

On April 7, 2016, Ursa Operating Company, LLC (Operator No. 10447) ("Ursa" or "Applicant"), filed a verified application pursuant to Commission Rule 303.c.(2) relating to Form 2s (Applications for Permit to Drill) and a Form 2A (Application for Oil and Gas Location Assessment) for permits to drill and surface location, respectively, for Ursa's BMC B Pad, ID No. 400927767 and associated wells (No API No.) with the proposed Oil and Gas Location on the Subject Lands.

APPLICABLE RULE

- Rule 303.c(2) provides, as amended on March 16, 2016:

(2) Request for Hearing.

A. An operator may request a hearing before the Commission on an Application for Permit-to-Drill, Form 2, and on an Oil and Gas Location Assessment, Form 2A, that is not a Large UMA Facility if the Director has not issued a decision within 75 days following a determination that the application is complete;

B. An operator may request a hearing before the Commission on an Oil and Gas Location Assessment, Form 2A, for a Large UMA Facility if the Director has not issued a decision within:

- i. 90 days following a determination that the application is complete, if:

a. At the time the Form 2A is submitted, the operator and the local government with land use authority reached agreement regarding the site for the proposed Large UMA Facility;

b. The Form 2A was excepted from the Rule 305A consultation process;
or

c. The local government with land use authority waived the 305A procedures in writing or did not timely respond in writing to the Notice of Intent to Construct.

ii. 120 days following a determination that the application is complete, if, at the time the Form 2A is submitted, the operator and the local government with land use authority had not reached agreement regarding the site for the proposed Large UMA Facility.

C. A hearing pursuant to either subpart A. or B. shall be expedited but will be held only after both the 20 days' notice and the newspaper notice are given as required by §34-60-108, C.R.S. However, the hearing can be held after the newspaper notice if all of the entities listed under Rule 503.b. waive the 20-day notice requirement.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, pursuant to §§ 34-60-101 to -130, C.R.S. and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 2 CCR 404-1, that the Commission has scheduled this matter for hearing on:

At hearing, the Commission will consider the Application and enter an order pursuant to its authority under the statute. **Any interested party desiring to protest or intervene should file with the Commission a written protest or intervention in accordance with Rule 509., no later than May 23, 2016.** Such interested party shall, at the same time, serve a copy of the protest or intervention to the person filing the application. One electronic (cogcc.hearings_unit@state.co.us), one original and two copies shall be filed with the Commission. **Anyone who files a protest or intervention must be able to participate in a**

prehearing conference during the week of May 23, 2016. Pursuant to Rule 511, if the matter is uncontested, it may be approved without a hearing.
