APPLICATION

On May 19, 2016, Caerus WashCo LLC ("Caerus" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to § 34-60-116 C.R.S. for an order to:

- 1) Vacate an approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit established by Order No. 535-13 for Section 6, Township 5 North, Range 60 West, 6th P.M., for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation;
- 2) Vacate Order No. 535-24 which pooled all interests in an approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit established by Order No. 535-13 for Section 6, Township 5 North, Range 60 West, 6th P.M., for the development and operation of the Niobrara Formation;
- 3) Establish an approximate 1280-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara and Codell Formations;
- 4) Approve a total of up to 28 horizontal wells within the unit, with 24 horizontal wells to be drilled to the Niobrara Formation and four horizontal wells to be drilled to the Codell Formation, with the productive interval of each wellbore located no closer than 600 feet from the unit boundaries, and no closer than 100 feet from the productive interval of any other wellbore located within the unit, unless an exception is granted by the Director;
- 5) Applicant states that the proposed wells will be located on no more than four wellpads within the unit or on adjacent lands, without exception granted by the Director.

- On April 27, 1998, the Commission adopted Rule 318A, the Greater Wattenberg Area Special Well Location, Spacing and Unit Designation Rule. Section 1, Township 5 North, Range 61 West, 6th P.M. is subject to this Rule for the Codell and Niobrara Formations.
- Rule 318.a. of the Rules and Regulations of the Oil and Gas Conservation Commission requires that wells drilled in excess of 2,500 feet in depth be located not less than 600 feet from any lease line, and located not less than 1,200 feet from any other producible or drilling oil or gas well when drilling to the same common source of supply. Section 6, Township 5 North, Range 60 West, 6th P.M. is subject to this Rule for the Codell Formation.
- On May 16, 2011, the Commission entered Order No. 535-13 which established an approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit for Section 6, Township 5 North, Range 60 West, 6th P.M. and approved up to two horizontal wells within each unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation
- On May 16, 2011, the Commission entered Order No. 535-24, which among other things, pool all nonconsenting interests in the approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit established for Section 6, Township 5 North, Range 60 West, 6th P.M., for the development and operation of the Niobrara Formation.


