APPLICATION

On May 19, 2016, Bonanza Creek Energy Operating Company, LLC (Operator No. 8960) (“Bonanza Creek” or “Applicant”), filed a verified application pursuant to Commission Rule 503.b(10) for an order to:

- 1) Revoke an Application for Permit to Drill, Form 2, for the Flaherty 18-7-10NBH Well (the “Flaherty Well”) of Edge Energy, LLC as the issuance of such Application for Permit to Drill is in violation of C.R.S. 34-60-107, C.R.S. 34-60-116(5) and C.R.S. 34-60-117.
- 2) Allow the Commission or Director to issue an immediate cease and desist order against Edge Energy, LLC prohibiting any drilling activities on the Flaherty Well.

PRIOR ORDERS

- On October 27, 2014, the Commission approved Order No. 407-1126 establishing an approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Subject Lands, and allowing up to five (5) horizontal wells within the 640-acre drilling and spacing unit for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell and Niobrara Formations, with the productive interval of the wellbore will be located no closer than 600 feet from the unit

boundaries, and no closer than 150 feet from the productive interval of any other wellbore located in the unit, without exception being granted by the Director.

#### APPLICABLE RULE

- Rule 503.b(10) provides:

b. Applications to the Commission may be filed by the following applicants:

(10) For purposes of seeking relief or a ruling from the Commission on any other matter not described in (1) through (9) above, only persons who can demonstrate that they are directly and adversely affected or aggrieved by the conduct of oil and gas operations or an order of the Commission and that their interest is entitled to legal protection under the Act may be an applicant.
