On June 30, 2016, Bill Barrett Corporation, Operator No. 10071 ("BBC" or "Applicant") filed a verified application pursuant to §34-60-116, C.R.S., for an order to:

- 1) Establish an approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands, and approve up to four horizontal wells within the proposed unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Niobrara Formation;
- 2) Establish an approximate 640-acre drilling and spacing unit for the Application Lands, and approve one horizontal well within the proposed unit, for the production of oil, gas and associated hydrocarbons from the Codell Formation;
- 3) Require the productive intervals of the wellbore to be no closer than 460 feet from unit boundaries, and no closer than 150 feet from the productive interval of any other wellbore located in the unit, unless an exception is granted by the Director.
- 4) Applicant states that the proposed wells shall be located on no more than one multi-well pad, unless an exception is granted by the Director.
